Dear Sailor

Space for dry-land berthing of boats is severely limited. For this reason the Management Committee feels that members who sail regularly should be put ahead of the rest when it comes to the allocation of spaces. Current entitlement is no guarantee of future entitlement.

If you have been allocated a berth for the 2009 season, the fee will appear on your Membership Subscription statement under the heading 'Berthing'. If a berthing fee has not been charged you will have to make a new application and join the waiting list by completing and returning the 'Berthing Application' request (overleaf).

All boat owners, whether they have pre-qualified for a berth or are using this opportunity to apply, should complete the Berthing Rules Agreement (below) if they wish to berth and/or launch from the Club's premises in 2009.

Berthing Rules

1. Boats berthed on Sailing Club land must be in a seaworthy condition.
2. Berth holders must, when applying for a berthing space, have an intention to use their boats regularly. (twice or more a month)
3. Boats are to be kept in their allocated space, unless moved with the permission of the Sailing Committee.
4. Boats must be adequately secured against the prevailing conditions.
5. The Sailing Committee reserves the right to impose a £50 fine for securing boats neglected by owners.
6. Your allocated space and vessel in it are your responsibility. Please ensure that both are kept in a presentable fashion.
7. The Club does not provide any storage space for road trailers.
8. Berthing is not allowed without a current berthing sticker prominently displayed.

To apply for berthing, complete the following sections as fully as possible. The Club is able to offer berthing for most classes of sailing dinghy, canoes, sailboards, and other small craft (tenders etc). We also have a number of moorings available for larger vessels.

A charge is made for Summer berthing (March to November) based on the area occupied by the boat at £9.63/m². Standard charges for the more popular classes of boat are provided in the Schedule 1 below.

There is a minimum charge of £57.88 for ground berths

Please Note: A maximum of two boats per family will be permitted, except in exceptional circumstances where two or more family members sail solo boats.

Calculate the total fee owing and send this form to the above address or hand to the Berthing Officer.

Do not include payment as you will be invoiced if berthing is approved.

This application cannot be accepted without a signed Berthing Agreement – please be sure to complete this section overleaf.
