Terms and Conditions of Membership (Constitution extract)

All members of Swanage Sailing Club are required to read and sign the Terms and Conditions of Membership. Any reference to "CLUB" includes officers, committee members, trustees and stewards of Swanage Sailing Club.

1. I confirm that all craft I berth or use at the club are fully INSURED including Third Party Insurance Liability cover for not less than £2,000,000.
2. I understand that members of the Club, their guests and visitors, may use the club premises and facilities entirely at their own risk and explicitly accept that: -
I understand that members of the Club, their guests and visitors, may use the club premises and facilities entirely at their own risk and explicitly accept that: -
 - a. The Club will not accept any liability for damage to or loss of Property belonging to members, their guests or visitors to the Club
 - b. The Club will not accept any liability for personal injury arising out of the use of the Club premises, and any other facilities of the Club, or, out of participation in any race organised by the Club, whether sustained by members, their guests or visitors or caused by the said members, guests or visitors, whether or not such damage or injury could have been attributed to or was occasioned by the neglect default or negligence of any of the officers, committee or servants of the club.
 - c. Before inviting any guest or visitors onto the premises or to participate in events organised by the Club, members will draw their attention to this rule.
3. All Members have the responsibility to conform to club policies to achieve a healthy and safe club environment and to take reasonable care of themselves and others. It is cumbent on the Club to advise the Members of such policies and responsibilities. Members have a responsibility to bring to the attention of the Club's serving flag officers any suspected health or injury hazards.
4. Racing: The Club shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/competitor, the skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, ever owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races and undertakes to provide Third Party Liability Insurance as detailed above.
5. Child and Junior Members. Parents and Guardians are warned that the Club is only able to provide rescue facilities during the hours of Club racing or during other organised activities. Parents and Guardians have full responsibility for their children, and must appreciate that the club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control. Even during Club racing the Club cannot accept responsibility for children, or any other persons whether engaged in racing, training or general sailing. A Parent/Guardian must be present at all times while children are participating in club activities.

IMPORTANT All members carrying out safety duties are required to watch the Safety Training Video (web site under sailing tab), and must have read and then abide by our Swanage Sailing Club Operating Procedures (web site in members area documents) when carrying out all Safety Duties.
